

## POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES

You use possessive adjectives to tell what belongs to someone or to show relationships.

In English, the possessive adjectives are **my, your, his, her, its, our, y'all's, their, and your (plural)**

Here are the possessive adjectives in Spanish:

mi	mis	nuestro	nuestra
		nuestros	nuestras
tu	tus	vuestro	vuestros
		vuestros	vuestras
su	sus	su	sus

Like other adjectives, possessive adjectives agree in **number** (singular or plural) with the nouns that **follow** them. However, only **nuestro** and **vuestro** also agree in **gender** (masculine or feminine).

\_\_\_\_\_ abuelo (our grandfather)                          \_\_\_\_\_ abuelos (our grandfathers)

\_\_\_\_\_ abuela (our grandmother)                          \_\_\_\_\_ abuelas (our grandmothers)

**Su** and **sus** can have many different meanings: **his, her, its, their and your**.

To be more specific, you can use *de* + noun or pronoun. Complete the following activity with either “su” or “sus”.

Las flores **de ella** (her flowers)                          \_\_\_\_\_ flores

Los globos **de Paco y Juan** (their balloons)                          \_\_\_\_\_ globos

When you don't know what the subject is, look at the word in parenthesis. (de mí, de ti, de él, de ella, de nosotros, etc...). Then, determine whether to use the **singular, plural, masculine or feminine** form of the possessive adjective by the noun that follows the blank. For example:

\_\_\_\_\_ hermanas (de mí). De mí tells us it has to be either "mi" or "mis". The word "hermanas" is feminine and plural, therefore the correct answer is "mis".

\_\_\_\_\_ globos (de nosotros). De nosotros tells us it has to be either "nuestro", "nuestra", "nuestros", or "nuestras". The word "globos" is masculine and plural, therefore the correct answer is "nuestros".
