*Some commands have irregular forms:			
poner=PON			

Present Progressive:

hacer=HAZ

*When you want to emphasize that an action is happening **RIGHT NOW**, you use the present progressive.

Present progressive= present tense of ESTAR + present participle (-ar> ando) (-er/-ir> iendo)

Yo ESTOY	Nosotros ESTAMOS
Tú ESTÁS	Vosotros ESTÁIS
ÉI ESTÁ	Ellos ESTÁN

In English it looks like this:

I am washing – yo estoy lavando	We are dancing – nosotros estamos bailando	
You are eating – tú estás comiendo	You all are making – vosotros estáis hacienda	
He is writing – él está escribiendo	They are opening – ellos están abriendo	

^{*}There are 2 "special" present participles that you'll need to know:

Leer = leyendo dormir = durmiendo
